
Arena and access:

Terrain and map

Map

Eggemoen published 2015, new survey 2017. 1:10.000, contour interval 5 m. The map is printed on waterproof paper (Teslin). Control numbers and code are printed by the controls. Some recent forestry has left tracks from forest machines. Only significant and continuous tracks are shown on the map. Debris from the forestry is marked on the map if it creates slow pace.

There are signs of former military activity with depressions marked with brown v, former armed posts marked with a black ring and there are also some ramparts.





Terrain

There are three different types of terrain. Main area is an open pine forest with high-speed running (break your own speed record!). Courses for adults and veterans have parts of difficult slopes with many details and demanding map reading. There is also an area with steep slopes.

A small railroad crosses the terrain. This is closed for traffic and you are allowed to cross it or run on it.





Team composition

Team composition should be registered on Eventor Thursday August 3rd 6 pm. If you have trouble with Eventor, use entry@nighawk.no

Team bags

Team bags can be collected at the information desk Friday 19:30 - 21:30. The bags contain number bids for all legs (night and day) and start lists. All runners should wear a number bib.

Payment

Foreign teams are invoiced prior to the event – or in case of late entries, you will pay at the event with NOK, Euro, SEK, credit card or VIPPS

Punching

Night Hawk emiTag touch free punching. Use your own emiTag, or have one free of charge for the event.

Do not touch the control. Check that the tag gives a light flash from the punch. GPS units are given to the top teams. emiTag and GPS equipment are collected at the finish for the night legs. New equipment is handed out in the morning.

All runners must register the start number and emitTag number before start in the in check area near the Finish GPS-tracking is shown live on internet during the competition



Results

Results are shown on information boards at the arena and published at www.nighthawk.no/live

During the competition on Saturday is it not allowed for the runners to follow the live results before their own leg.

Children's courses

Saturday there will be a kid's course and a short open course approx. 2 km with start 300 south from the arena. Entries at the start. NOK 20 for kid's course, NOK 50 for short open course. Prices for all participants.

Camping close to arena with access to cold clean water and toilet trailer. NOK 100,- per night. **Be aware of the fire hazard and do not make open fire at the camp site.**

Course and starting information

Start

All night legs have mass start ca 1,5 km from the arena. See timetable for departures. Departure is south at the arena. For all night courses there are 700 m signposted routes (to the start control and to the finish line).

Saturday: chase start at the arena. All legs have approx. 800m signposted routes (to the start control, passing the arena and to the finish line).

All legs Saturday, except the first leg for men, women and veterans will pass the arena and continue 300m till a new start control.

Night Hawk girls (D 12-16) and boys (H 12-16)

Mass start girls and boys, legs 1 and 2 Friday at 22:20

Both legs are straight (no forking), runners from legs 1 and 2 can run together (if they want).

Check-in for emiTag at the arena until 21:30

Common departure at 21:50

Restart (mass start) for all legs for all teams that have not yet started will be after the first teams have entered the final finish.


Estimated mass start approx. 11:55 for girls and boys, approx. 15.00 for all other classes.

Night Hawk Ringeriksløpet Point orienteering Sunday August 6th 2017



Arena: Eggemoen, marked from E 16 between Hønefoss and Jevnaker. From Hønefoss ca 5 km. 5 - 10 minutes walking from parking to arena. Same arena as the Night Hawk relay Friday/Saturday.

Small kids offer: NOK 20, Childrens care – free of charge

Map and terrain: Map Eggemoen scale 1:10.000, published 2015 and updated 2017. There are three different types of terrain. Main area is an open pine forest with high-speed running. The vegetation varies from big pine forest, mixed forest, young forest and some areas with tracks from forest machines. There is many paths in the area.

A small railroad crosses the terrain. This is closed for traffic and can be crossed and run on.

Registration and fee: Registration via Eventor within Monday July 31. Later registry within Thursday August 3th at 20:00. After that time registration via e-mail to stig@melling.no or at arena within one hour before start as long as we have maps available.

Starting fee: D/H -16 NOK 70, D/H 17- NOK 140. Late registry fee + 50% (not D/H -12). Direct courses A, B, C and N long; NOK 100. Foreign participant must pay cash at arena before start.

Information about the competition: For all classes it is point orienteering. It is a competition about collecting as many points as possible from the 20 controls on the map. This has to be done within 30 minutes. The controls have values from 1 to 20 where the controls with least value is close to arena and is most easy. The controls with highest value is far from the arena and more difficult. If the competitor use more than 30 minutes there will be a redraw of points with 5 point per started overtime minute. If more competitors have the same amount of points, the one with shortest time will be ranked first Map with controls is available from 10:30. Five controls close to arena will be at new beginners level so there is a possibility for new beginners to participate as well

Start: Free start for all between 11:00 and 12:00. Approx. 10 minutes to walk from arena to start.
