PROGRAM Sunday, April 21th

VENUE:

Saturday: Signposted from the junction of roads RV111/FV627 by

Sunday: Signposted from exit 1 from E6 north of the border Norway/Sweden in both directions.

PARKING:

Saturday: On solid ground, up to 700m walking to the arena.

Parking fee 20 NOK

Sunday: On the arena, no parking fee. COMPETITION AND CLASSES:
Main classes: Elite-. A- and B/N-level

The event is arranged as a two-day overall competition.

Youth competition Saturday: WM 0-12 (B/N-level) and WM 13-16 (A-level), Open (A-level). In the class WM 0-12 parents/adults are allowed to assist the competitors at the course. In the Open class there are no age restrictions (also open for those older than 16 years old).

COMBINE VARSPRETTEN/-STAFETTEN AND TRAILO

On Saturday it is possible to combine participation in the foot-o events and TrailO. Those running Vårspretten may compete in the TrailO main classes before running, while those competing in Vårstafetten may compete in the TrailO youth competition afterwards. See the separate invitation for the foot-o events on the web pages for the event.

YOUTH COMPETITION

Saturday a separate (free) TrailO competition for youths will be arranged. Instructors will be available. The ordinary entry deadline applies.

INTRODUCTION TO TRAILO

An introduction to TrailO will be published on the events web pages in due time for the competition. It is recommended that those without previous experience with TrailO take a look this before the event.

MAP/TERRAIN:

Saturday: Revised in 2013 by Morten Dalby. Scale 1:4000, eq. 2,5m, ISSOM. The competition area is partly with few details and close to urban areas. The visibility varies from very good to poor. The route goes in everything from forest to urban areas, and fields with sight into forest areas. The route goes on asphalt and is mainly flat with a few steep sections.

Sunday: Redrawn TrailO map 2012/2013 by Morten Dalby. Scale 1:4000, eq. 2.5m, ISOM. The competition area is located on a peninsula with open forest, a few huts and quite a few paths in a terrain with both small scale and large scale contour features. The area is rich on both black and brown details. The route consists mainly of bigger paths on rather flat surface except for a few steeper sections.

Both maps are also revised for TrailO.

COURSE LENGTHS

All classes Saturday: 1500-1800m. All classes Sunday: 600-1200m.

START:

Saturday: 300m to start in all classes. Sunday: 200m to start in all classes.

FINISH:

Saturday: Finish at the arena.

Sunday: 700m to walk back to the arena after finish.

TIMED CONTROLS:

Saturday: Before start in main classes, after finish in the youth competition.

Sunday: Before start in class A and B/N, after finish in class Elite.

PRIZES: Prizes will be given for the overall competition according to the rules of the Norwegian Orienteering Federation in addition to prizes for the winners each day. Participation prizes in the youth classes.

CHILD CARE:

Saturday: Free and open for all children over 2 years old. Sunday: No child care.
