

## **Rules for Nordic Junior** Meeting

Each country can nominate up to 3 men and 3 women to each competition class (H/D18 and H/D20).

Only the two best athletes in each class get points. Scores for each class are calculated as follows:

- 1. Place 7 points
- 2. Place 5 points
- 3. Place 4 points
- 4. Place 3 points
- 5. Place 2 points
- 1 point 6. Place

Team with highest scores after two-day competitions is awarded a challenge trophy.
